

Texas: District 17

The Need for Services

- 37,660 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 17th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 23 family planning clinics in Texas's 17th congressional district. 10 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,370 women, including 4,350 teenagers.* 25% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 33% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 28% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 17th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 17th congressional district serve 1,260 women, including 410 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 17th congressional district.*
