

## Texas: District 18

### The Need for Services

- 59,400 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 18th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 23 family planning clinics in Texas's 18th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 13 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 28,360 women, including 10,330 teenagers.\* 36% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 28% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 18th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 18th congressional district serve 7,660 women, including 4,880 teenagers.\* 20% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 22% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 58% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 18th congressional district.*
