



## Texas: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 37,500 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Texas's 2nd congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,710 women, including 3,580 teenagers.\* 19% are served by health departments, 37% are served by hospitals, 41% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 3% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 13 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 6 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 2nd congressional district serve 7,240 women, including 1,900 teenagers.\* 28% are served by health departments, 65% are served by hospitals, 2% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
