

Texas: District 20

The Need for Services

- 52,810 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 20th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in Texas's 20th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 32,390 women, including 10,370 teenagers.* 13% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 53% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 24% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 20th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 20th congressional district serve 12,010 women, including 1,810 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 27% are served by hospitals, 73% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 20th congressional district.*
