

Texas: District 24

The Need for Services

- 46,730 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 24th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in Texas's 24th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,150 women, including 5,310 teenagers.* 11% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 61% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 27% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 24th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 24th congressional district serve 11,410 women, including 4,040 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 76% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 24% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 24th congressional district.*
