

## Texas: District 25

### The Need for Services

- 46,760 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 25th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Texas's 25th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 27,310 women, including 4,380 teenagers.\* 53% are served by health departments, 9% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 25th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 25th congressional district serve 7,470 women, including 1,650 teenagers.\* 85% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 15% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 25th congressional district.*
