

Texas: District 27

The Need for Services

- 68,340 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 27th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 24 family planning clinics in Texas's 27th congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 8 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 27,820 women, including 6,540 teenagers.* 30% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 56% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 27th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 27th congressional district serve 7,090 women, including 2,070 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 70% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 27th congressional district.*
