

Texas: District 28

The Need for Services

- 66,800 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 28th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 21 family planning clinics in Texas's 28th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 12 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,370 women, including 4,900 teenagers.* 20% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 44% are served by Planned Parenthood, 36% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 28th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 28th congressional district serve 6,780 women, including 1,730 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 91% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 28th congressional district.*
