

## Texas: District 29

### The Need for Services

- 57,490 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 29th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 7 family planning clinics in Texas's 29th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,720 women, including 2,910 teenagers.\* 53% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 7% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 0 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 29th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 29th congressional district serve 0 women, including 0 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 29th congressional district.*
