

## Texas: District 3

### The Need for Services

- 15,340 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 3rd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 7 family planning clinics in Texas's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,060 women, including 3,010 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 70% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 3rd congressional district serve 5,060 women, including 880 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 36% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 64% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
