

## Texas: District 30

### The Need for Services

- 50,740 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 30th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Texas's 30th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 10 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 44,470 women, including 4,850 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 9% are served by Planned Parenthood, 20% are served by community health centers and 70% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 30th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 30th congressional district serve 29,990 women, including 2,510 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 30th congressional district.*
