



Texas: District 31

The Need for Services

- 37,070 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 31th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Texas's 31th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 3 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,320 women, including 3,550 teenagers.* 3% are served by health departments, 16% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 42% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 31th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 31th congressional district serve 9,360 women, including 1,280 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 27% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 73% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 31th congressional district.*
