



## Texas: District 32

### The Need for Services

- 31,380 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 32th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 7 family planning clinics in Texas's 32th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,380 women, including 2,680 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 32th congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 32th congressional district serve 1,130 women, including 80 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 32th congressional district.*
