

Texas: District 4

The Need for Services

- 31,440 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in Texas's 4th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,180 women, including 4,640 teenagers.* 32% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 25% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 4th congressional district serve 5,410 women, including 1,400 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 30% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 58% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
