

## Texas: District 5

### The Need for Services

- 30,630 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 5th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in Texas's 5th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,940 women, including 2,730 teenagers.\* 16% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 60% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 5th congressional district serve 3,670 women, including 1,410 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 61% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 39% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
