



Texas: District 6

The Need for Services

- 22,100 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 6th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in Texas's 6th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 7,710 women, including 2,980 teenagers.* 1% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 98% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 6th congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 6th congressional district serve 2,320 women, including 920 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
