

Utah: District 1

The Need for Services

- 46,140 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Utah's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in Utah's 1st congressional district. 11 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,510 women, including 2,560 teenagers.* 19% are served by health departments, 4% are served by hospitals, 63% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Utah's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Utah's 1st congressional district serve 7,250 women, including 1,940 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 92% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
