



Utah: District 2

The Need for Services

- 42,760 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Utah's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 27 family planning clinics in Utah's 2nd congressional district. 9 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 10 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,350 women, including 3,330 teenagers.* 6% are served by health departments, 35% are served by hospitals, 44% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 10% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Utah's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 8 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Utah's 2nd congressional district serve 1,460 women, including 430 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
