

Utah: District 3

The Need for Services

- 58,220 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Utah's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Utah's 3rd congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,790 women, including 4,510 teenagers.* 6% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in Utah's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Utah's 3rd congressional district serve 12,720 women, including 4,240 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 99% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
