



Virginia: District 2

The Need for Services

- 31,670 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Virginia's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Virginia's 2nd congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 7,770 women, including 1,940 teenagers.* 54% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 32% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Virginia's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Virginia's 2nd congressional district serve 4,170 women, including 1,120 teenagers.* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
