

Virginia: District 3

The Need for Services

- 67,190 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Virginia's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 21 family planning clinics in Virginia's 3rd congressional district. 11 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,400 women, including 3,250 teenagers.* 42% are served by health departments, 15% are served by hospitals, 15% are served by Planned Parenthood, 28% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Virginia's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 10 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Virginia's 3rd congressional district serve 6,890 women, including 1,880 teenagers.* 72% are served by health departments, 27% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
