

Washington: District 2

The Need for Services

- 34,250 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Washington's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 19 family planning clinics in Washington's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 9 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,080 women, including 6,750 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 91% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Washington's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 8 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Washington's 2nd congressional district serve 11,810 women, including 4,820 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
