

Washington: District 3

The Need for Services

- 35,360 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Washington's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 18 family planning clinics in Washington's 3rd congressional district. 11 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,780 women, including 5,580 teenagers.* 30% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 57% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 14 of the family planning clinics in Washington's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 11 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Washington's 3rd congressional district serve 10,670 women, including 4,310 teenagers.* 39% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 46% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
