

## Washington: District 6

### The Need for Services

- 44,130 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Washington's 6th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 28 family planning clinics in Washington's 6th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 9 are run by community health centers and 10 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 23,060 women, including 7,730 teenagers.\* 25% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 58% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 7% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 14 of the family planning clinics in Washington's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Washington's 6th congressional district serve 9,000 women, including 3,710 teenagers.\* 65% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 13% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 10% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
