

## Washington: District 8

### The Need for Services

- 16,960 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Washington's 8th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 5 family planning clinics in Washington's 8th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 7,080 women, including 2,270 teenagers.\* 21% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 78% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Washington's 8th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Washington's 8th congressional district serve 7,040 women, including 2,260 teenagers.\* 21% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 79% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 8th congressional district.*
