

## Washington: District 9

### The Need for Services

- 30,980 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Washington's 9th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Washington's 9th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,970 women, including 5,310 teenagers.\* 39% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 51% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Washington's 9th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Washington's 9th congressional district serve 9,380 women, including 4,360 teenagers.\* 59% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 37% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 9th congressional district.*
