



## West Virginia: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 29,910 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in West Virginia's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 43 family planning clinics in West Virginia's 2nd congressional district. 16 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 15 are run by community health centers and 11 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,170 women, including 5,780 teenagers.\* 61% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 18% are served by community health centers and 21% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 37 of the family planning clinics in West Virginia's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 15 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 12 are run by community health centers and 9 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in West Virginia's 2nd congressional district serve 18,610 women, including 5,600 teenagers.\* 62% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
