

West Virginia: District 3

The Need for Services

- 43,550 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in West Virginia's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 68 family planning clinics in West Virginia's 3rd congressional district. 16 are run by health departments, 7 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 31 are run by community health centers and 14 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 23,670 women, including 6,910 teenagers.* 44% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 42% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 66 of the family planning clinics in West Virginia's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 16 are run by health departments, 6 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 30 are run by community health centers and 14 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in West Virginia's 3rd congressional district serve 23,500 women, including 6,850 teenagers.* 44% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 42% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
