

## Wisconsin: District 3

### The Need for Services

- 43,360 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Wisconsin's 3rd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 28 family planning clinics in Wisconsin's 3rd congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 15 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,190 women, including 4,520 teenagers.\* 26% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 11% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 61% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in Wisconsin's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Wisconsin's 3rd congressional district serve 7,000 women, including 2,680 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
