

Wyoming: at-large

The Need for Services

- 29,340 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Wyoming's at-large congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 32 family planning clinics in Wyoming's at-large congressional district. 11 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 20 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,770 women, including 5,610 teenagers.* 29% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 5% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 66% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 22 of the family planning clinics in Wyoming's at-large congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 17 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Wyoming's at-large congressional district serve 13,390 women, including 4,540 teenagers.* 28% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 72% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in at-large congressional district.*
